**Re:** Changes in Part-D wrap benefit

MaineCare would like to inform Pharmacy Providers of upcoming changes to the Part D wrap benefit beginning August 12, 2013 pursuant to LD 1509 for the Fiscal years ending June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2015.

The Department is implementing changes for some Drugs for the Elderly (DEL) members and will no longer pay for the Medicare Part D co-payment and deductible under the Part D wrap benefit. This change **ONLY** applies to individuals who are eligible for Medicare Savings Program (MSP), but are not eligible for full MaineCare. DEL members **without** MSP will continue to have co-payment and deductible coverage. **This change is effective August 12, 2013.**

Pharmacists may not be able to easily identify MSP members based on the information available to them. To ease this transition, GHS will be incorporating specific Point of Sale (POS) messaging back to the pharmacies that will aid in identifying members who no longer receive MaineCare's assistance in paying for deductibles and coinsurance. The messaging that the pharmacies receive if they submit a secondary claim for a Part D claim for these members will read **"Reject-41 Submit bill to other processor or primary payer - No Copay Benefit - Allowed /Available"** or **"Reject-76 plan limitations exceeded - No coverage for Part D Deductible or Gap"** depending on whether the claim submitted is co-pay or deductible related.
