Re: PDL Updates as of 01/12/2018

The following are updates and clarifications to the Maintenance Drug list.

MaineCare would like to inform providers that the following drug classes (Antipsychotics, Antidepressants, and Mood Stabilizers) will be <u>temporarily suspended as of 01-12-2018</u> from the 90-day Maintenance requirement. MaineCare will implement these particular drug classes at a later date utilizing a modified Maintenance rule, and a future communication will be sent to providers with details.

All other medications currently coded as "maintenance" will continue to require a 90-day fill after an initial 30-day fill. The MaineCare Maintenance List can be viewed at:

The following are exempt from the 90-day Maintenance Rule:

- Brand Name medications
- Controlled substances
- MaineRx Plus
- 5B (Special Services Waiver) RAC (eligibility) code
- Those coded as Nursing Home by RAC (eligibility) code

The following are updates and clarifications to the MaineCare PDL.

The following updates have been made since 01-01-2018:

- The following 3 Generic Methylphenidate ER 18 mg, 27 mg, 36 mg, & 54 mg manufacturers will be preferred within dose limits and criteria:
 - Actavis
 - o Kremers Urban
 - o Mallinckrodt
- All covered NDCs of Atomoxetine are now preferred within dose limits.
