Dear Low Cost Drug Member:

We are sending you this letter because you get the Maine Low Cost Drug benefit. This letter is to tell you about changes we are making to this benefit to keep your drug prices down.

What changes are you making?

There are drug companies that will give large discounts for some drugs. We have a list of these drugs. To get the discount, your provider must choose drugs from this list when writing your prescription.

What happens if the drug I usually take is not on this list?

If the drug you need is not on this list, you can:

- buy the drug outside the benefit and pay the full price; or
- ask your doctor if there is another drug on the list that you can use.

With these changes, you will still get quality, effective services.
